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AN ACT concerning motor vehicles; relating to distinctive license plates;
 providing for the Kansas City Chiefs license plate, the sporting Kansas
 City license plate-and{,} the Sedgwick county zoo license plate{, the
 Kansas City royals license plate-and, the Kansas City current license
 plate} and the Topeka zoo license plate.

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Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

New Section 1. (a) On and after January 1, 2025, any owner or lessee 8 9 of one or more passenger vehicles or trucks registered for a gross weight of 20,000 pounds or less who is a resident of Kansas, upon compliance 10 with the provisions of this section, may be issued one Kansas City Chiefs 11 license plate for each such passenger vehicle or truck. Such license plate 12 shall be issued for the same time as other license plates upon proper 13 registration and payment of the regular license fee as provided in K.S.A. 8-14 15 143, and amendments thereto, and the payment to the county treasurer of 16 the logo use royalty payment.

(b) The Kansas City Chiefs football club, inc., may authorize the use of the organization's logo to be affixed on license plates as provided by this section. Any motor vehicle owner or lessee shall pay an amount of not less than \$25 nor more than \$100, as determined by the Kansas City Chiefs football club, inc., as a logo use royalty payment for each such license plate to be issued. The logo use royalty payment shall be paid to the county treasurer.

24 (c) Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section may 25 make application for such license plate not less than 60 days prior to such person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and furnished 26 27 by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for such license plate shall 28 pay to the county treasurer the logo use royalty payment. Application for registration of a passenger vehicle or truck and issuance of the license 29 plate under this section shall be made by the owner or lessee in a manner 30 31 prescribed by the director of vehicles upon forms furnished by the director.

1 (d) No registration or license plate issued under this section shall be 2 transferable to any other person.

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(e) The director of vehicles may transfer a Kansas City Chiefs 4 football elub, inc., license plate from a leased vehicle to a purchased vehicle

6 (f) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made annually, 7 upon payment of the fee prescribed in K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments 8 thereto, and in the manner prescribed in K.S.A. 8-132(b), and amendments 9 thereto. No renewal of registration shall be made to any applicant until 10 such applicant provides to the county treasurer the annual royalty payment. If such annual royalty payment is not made to the county treasurer, the 11 12 applicant shall be required to comply with the provisions of K.S.A. 8-143, 13 and amendments thereto, and return the license plate to the county treasurer of such person's residence. 14

15 (g) The Kansas City Chiefs football club, inc., with the approval of 16 the director of vehicles, shall design a plate to be issued under the 17 provisions of this section.

18 (h) As a condition of receiving the Kansas City Chiefs license plate 19 and any subsequent registration renewal of such license plate, the applicant 20 shall consent to the division authorizing the division's release of motor 21 vehicle record information, including the applicant's name, address, 22 royalty payment amount, plate number and vehicle type to the Kansas City 23 Chiefs football club, inc., and the state treasurer.

24 (i) Annual Kansas City Chiefs license plate fee payments collected by 25 county treasurers under this section shall be remitted to the state treasurer in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments 26 27 thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance, the state treasurer shall 28 deposit the entire amount in the state treasury to the credit of the Kansas City Chiefs license plate fund, which is hereby created in the state treasury 29 30 and shall be administered by the state treasurer. All expenditures from the 31 Kansas City Chiefs license plate fund shall be made in accordance with 32 appropriation acts upon warrants of the director of accounts and reports 33 issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the state treasurer or the state 34 treasurer's designee. Payments from the Kansas City Chiefs license plate 35 fund shall be made on a monthly basis to the Hunt family foundation.

36 (a) On and after January 1, 2025, any owner or lessee of Sec. 2. 37 one or more passenger vehicles or trucks registered for a gross weight of 38 20,000 pounds or less who is a resident of Kansas, upon compliance 39 with the provisions of this section, may be issued one sporting Kansas 40 City license plate for each such passenger vehicle or truck. Such license plate shall be issued for the same time as other license plates upon 41 42 proper registration and payment of the regular license fee as provided in 43 K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and the payment to the county

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1 treasurer of the logo use royalty payment.

2 (b) OnGoal, LLC, may authorize the use of the organization's logo 3 to be affixed on license plates as provided by this section. Any motor 4 vehicle owner or lessee shall pay an amount of not less than \$25 nor 5 more than \$100, as determined by OnGoal, LLC, as a logo use royalty 6 payment for each such license plate to be issued. The logo use royalty 7 payment shall be paid to the county treasurer.

(c) Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section may 8 make application for such license plate not less than 60 days prior to 9 such person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and 10 furnished by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for such license 11 plate shall pay to the county treasurer the logo use royalty payment. 12 Application for registration of a passenger vehicle or truck and issuance 13 of the license plate under this section shall be made by the owner or 14 lessee in a manner prescribed by the director of vehicles upon forms 15 16 furnished by the director.

17 (d) No registration or license plate issued under this section shall
18 be transferable to any other person.

19 (e) The director of vehicles may transfer a sporting Kansas City 20 license plate from a leased vehicle to a purchased vehicle.

21 (f) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made 22 annually, upon payment of the fee prescribed in K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and in the manner prescribed in K.S.A. 8-132, and 23 amendments thereto. No renewal of registration shall be made to any 24 25 applicant until such applicant provides to the county treasurer the annual royalty payment. If such annual royalty payment is not made to 26 the county treasurer, the applicant shall be required to comply with the 27 28 provisions of K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and return the 29 license plate to the county treasurer of such person's residence.

30 (g) OnGoal, LLC, with the approval of the director of vehicles, shall 31 design a plate to be issued under the provisions of this section.

(h) As a condition of receiving the sporting Kansas City license
plate and any subsequent registration renewal of such license plate, the
applicant shall consent to the division authorizing the division's release
of motor vehicle record information, including the applicant's name,
address, royalty payment amount, plate number and vehicle type to
OnGoal, LLC, and the state treasurer.

(i) Annual sporting Kansas City license plate fee payments collected
 by county treasurers under this section shall be remitted to the state
 treasurer in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and
 amendments thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance, the state
 treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in the state treasury to the
 credit of the sporting Kansas City license plate fund, which is hereby

1 created in the state treasury and shall be administered by the state treasurer. All expenditures from the sporting Kansas City license plate 2 fund shall be made in accordance with appropriation acts upon 3 4 warrants of the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to 5 vouchers approved by the state treasurer or the state treasurer's designee. Payments from the sporting Kansas City license plate fund 6 7 shall be made on a monthly basis to the Kansas City soccer foundation 8 in support of the victory project.

Sec. 3. (a) On and after January 1, 2025, any owner or lessee of 9 one or more passenger vehicles or trucks registered for a gross weight of 10 20,000 pounds or less, who is a resident of Kansas, upon compliance 11 with the provisions of this section, may be issued one Sedgwick county 12 zoo license plate for each such passenger vehicle or truck. Such license 13 plate shall be issued for the same time as other license plates upon 14 proper registration and payment of the regular license fee as provided in 15 16 K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and either the payment to the 17 county treasurer of the logo use royalty payment or the presentation of the annual logo use authorization statement provided for in subsection 18 19 *(b)*.

20 The Sedgwick county zoological society may authorize the use (b) 21 of the organization's logo to be affixed on license plates as provided by 22 this section. Any motor vehicle owner or lessee may apply annually to 23 the Sedgwick county zoological society for use of such logo. Such owner 24 or lessee shall pay an amount of not less than \$25 nor more than \$100 to 25 the Sedgwick county zoological society as a logo use royalty payment for each such license plate to be issued. The logo use royalty payment shall 26 27 be paid to either:

(1) The Sedgwick county zoological society, which shall issue to the
 motor vehicle owner or lessee, without further charge, a logo use
 authorization statement that shall be presented by the motor vehicle
 owner or lessee at the time of registration; or

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(2) the county treasurer.

33 (c) Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section may 34 make application for such license plate not less than 60 days prior to 35 such person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and 36 furnished by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for such license 37 plate shall either provide the annual logo use authorization statement 38 provided for in subsection (b) or pay to the county treasurer the logo use 39 royalty payment. Application for registration of a passenger vehicle or truck and issuance of the license plate under this section shall be made 40 by the owner or lessee in a manner prescribed by the director of vehicles 41 upon forms furnished by the director. 42

43 (d) No registration or license plate issued under this section shall

1 *be transferable to any other person.*

2 (e) The director of vehicles may transfer a Sedgwick county zoo 3 license plate from a leased vehicle to a purchased vehicle.

(f) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made 4 annually, upon payment of the fee prescribed in K.S.A. 8-143, and 5 amendments thereto, and in the manner prescribed in K.S.A. 8-132, and 6 7 amendments thereto. No renewal of registration shall be made to any applicant until such applicant provides to the county treasurer either the 8 annual logo use authorization statement provided for in subsection (b) 9 or the payment of the annual royalty payment. If such statement is not 10 presented at the time of registration or sent by the Sedgwick county 11 zoological society, or the annual royalty payment is not made to the 12 county treasurer, the applicant shall be required to comply with the 13 provisions of K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and return the 14 license plate to the county treasurer of such person's residence. 15

16 (g) The Sedgwick county zoological society shall provide to all 17 county treasurers an electronic mail address where applicants can 18 contact the Sedgwick county zoological society for information 19 concerning the application process or the status of such applicant's 20 license plate application.

(h) The Sedgwick county zoological society, with the approval of the
 director of vehicles, shall design a plate to be issued under the provisions
 of this section.

(i) As a condition of receiving the Sedgwick county zoo license plate
 and any subsequent registration renewal of such license plate, the
 applicant shall consent to the division authorizing the division's release
 of motor vehicle record information, including the applicant's name,
 address, royalty payment amount, plate number and vehicle type, to the
 Sedgwick county zoological society and the state treasurer.

(j) The collection and remittance of annual royalty payments by the
county treasurer shall be subject to the provisions of K.S.A. 8-1,141(h),
and amendments thereto.

33 (a) On and after January 1, 2025, any owner or lessee of *{Sec. 4.* one or more passenger vehicles or trucks registered for a gross weight of 34 20,000 pounds or less who is a resident of Kansas, upon compliance 35 with the provisions of this section, may be issued one Kansas City royals 36 37 license plate for each such passenger vehicle or truck. Such license plate shall be issued for the same time as other license plates upon proper 38 39 registration and payment of the regular license fee as provided in K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and the payment to the county treasurer 40 of the logo use royalty payment. 41

42 (b) The Kansas City royals may authorize the use of the 43 organization's logo to be affixed on license plates as provided by this section. Any motor vehicle owner or lessee shall pay an amount of not
 less than \$25 but not more than \$100, as determined by the Kansas City
 royals as a logo use royalty payment for each such license plate to be
 issued. The logo use royalty payment shall be paid to the county
 treasurer.

(c) Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section may 6 7 make application for such license plate not less than 60 days prior to such person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and 8 furnished by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for such license 9 plate shall pay to the county treasurer the logo use royalty payment. 10 Application for registration of a passenger vehicle or truck and issuance 11 of the license plate under this section shall be made by the owner or 12 lessee in a manner prescribed by the director of vehicles upon forms 13 furnished by the director. 14

(d) No registration or license plate issued under this section shall
 be transferable to any other person.

(e) The director of vehicles may transfer a Kansas City royals
license plate from a leased vehicle to a purchased vehicle.

(f) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made 19 annually, upon payment of the fee prescribed in K.S.A. 8-143, and 20 21 amendments thereto, and in the manner prescribed in K.S.A. 8-132, and 22 amendments thereto. No renewal of registration shall be made to any applicant until such applicant provides to the county treasurer the 23 24 annual royalty payment. If such annual royalty payment is not made to 25 the county treasurer, the applicant shall be required to comply with the provisions of K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and return the 26 27 license plate to the county treasurer of such person's residence.

(g) The Kansas City royals with the approval of the director of
 vehicles, shall design a plate to be issued under the provisions of this
 section.

(h) As a condition of receiving the Kansas City royals license plate
and any subsequent registration renewal of such license plate, the
applicant shall consent to the division authorizing the division's release
of motor vehicle record information, including the applicant's name,
address, royalty payment amount, plate number and vehicle type to the
Kansas City royals and the state treasurer.

(i) Annual Kansas City royals license plate fee payments collected
by county treasurers under this section shall be remitted to the state
treasurer in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and
amendments thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance, the state
treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in the state treasury to the
credit of the Kansas City royals license plate fund, which is hereby
created in the state treasury and shall be administered by the state

1 treasurer. All expenditures from the Kansas City royals license plate fund shall be made in accordance with appropriation acts upon warrants of the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the state treasurer or the state treasurer's designee. Payments from the Kansas City royals license plate fund shall be made on a monthly basis to<u>a charity approved by</u> the Kansas City royals foundation.

(a) On and after January 1, 2025, any owner or lessee of 8 Sec. 5. one or more passenger vehicles or trucks registered for a gross weight of 9 20,000 pounds or less who is a resident of Kansas, upon compliance 10 with the provisions of this section, may be issued one Kansas City 11 current license plate for each such passenger vehicle or truck. Such 12 license plate shall be issued for the same time as other license plates 13 upon proper registration and payment of the regular license fee as 14 provided in K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and the payment to 15 16 the county treasurer of the logo use royalty payment.

17 (b) The Kansas City current may authorize the use of the 18 organization's logo to be affixed on license plates as provided by this 19 section. Any motor vehicle owner or lessee shall pay an amount of not 20 less than \$25 but not more than \$100, as determined by the Kansas City 21 current as a logo use royalty payment for each such license plate to be 22 issued. The logo use royalty payment shall be paid to the county 23 treasurer.

24 (c) Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section may 25 make application for such license plate not less than 60 days prior to such person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and 26 furnished by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for such license 27 28 plate shall pay to the county treasurer the logo use royalty payment. 29 Application for registration of a passenger vehicle or truck and issuance of the license plate under this section shall be made by the owner or 30 lessee in a manner prescribed by the director of vehicles upon forms 31 32 furnished by the director.

(i) Annual Kansas City current license plate fee payments collected 12 13 by county treasurers under this section shall be remitted to the state treasurer in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and 14 amendments thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance, the state 15 treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in the state treasury to the 16 17 credit of the Kansas City current license plate fund, which is hereby 18 created in the state treasury and shall be administered by the state 19 treasurer. All expenditures from the Kansas City current license plate fund shall be made in accordance with appropriation acts upon 20 21 warrants of the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to 22 vouchers approved by the state treasurer or the state treasurer's 23 designee. Payments from the Kansas City current license plate fund 24 shall be made on a monthly basis to the united way of greater Kansas 25 City.

Sec. 6. (a) On and after January 1, 2025, any owner or lessee of 26 27 one or more passenger vehicles or trucks registered for a gross weight 28 of 20,000 pounds or less who is a resident of Kansas, upon compliance 29 with the provisions of this section, may be issued one Topeka zoo license plate for each such passenger vehicle or truck. Such license 30 31 plate shall be issued for the same time as other license plates upon 32 proper registration and payment of the regular license fee as provided 33 in K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and either the payment to 34 the county treasurer of the logo use royalty payment or the 35 presentation of the annual logo use authorization statement provided 36 for in subsection (b).

(b) The friends of the Topeka zoo, inc., may authorize the use of the organization's logo to be affixed on license plates as provided by this section. Any motor vehicle owner or lessee may apply annually to the friends of the Topeka zoo, inc., for use of such logo. Such owner or lessee shall pay an amount of not less than \$25 nor more than \$100 to the friends of the Topeka zoo, inc., as a logo use royalty payment for each such license plate to be issued. The logo use royalty payment 1 shall be paid to either:

2 (1) The friends of the Topeka zoo, inc., which shall issue to the 3 motor vehicle owner or lessee, without further charge, a logo use 4 authorization statement that shall be presented by the motor vehicle 5 owner or lessee at the time of registration; or

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(2) the county treasurer.

7 (c) Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section 8 may make application for such license plate not less than 60 days prior to such person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed 9 10 and furnished by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for such license plate shall either provide the annual logo use authorization 11 12 statement provided for in subsection (b) or pay to the county treasurer the logo use royalty payment. Application for registration of a 13 passenger vehicle or truck and issuance of the license plate under this 14 section shall be made by the owner or lessee in a manner prescribed 15 16 by the director of vehicles upon forms furnished by the director.

17 (d) No registration or license plate issued under this section shall18 be transferable to any other person.

(e) The director of vehicles may transfer a Topeka zoo licenseplate from a leased vehicle to a purchased vehicle.

21 (f) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made 22 annually, upon payment of the fee prescribed in K.S.A. 8-143, and 23 amendments thereto, and in the manner prescribed in K.S.A. 8-132, 24 and amendments thereto. (h) The friends of the Topeka zoo, inc., with the approval of the
director of vehicles, shall design a plate to be issued under the
provisions of this section.
