A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION rejecting the rates of compensation and salary for members of the Legislature set by the Legislative Compensation Commission.

WHEREAS, The Legislature has authority to reject the rates of compensation and salary for members of the Legislature set by the Legislative Compensation Commission in the Commission's Order dated October 19, 2023, and published in the Journal of the Senate and the Journal of the House of Representatives on January 8, 2024, pursuant to K.S.A. 2023 Supp. 46-3102, 2023 Senate Bill No. 229: Now, therefore, Be it resolved by the Senate of the State of Kansas, the House of Representatives concurring therein: That the rates of compensation and salary for members of the Legislature set by the Legislative Compensation Commission are rejected pursuant to K.S.A. 2023 Supp. 46-3102, and the rates of compensation and salary for members of the Legislature prevailing for the 2024 Legislative session as provided by law
