1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION rejecting the rates of compensation
2 and salary for members of the Legislature set by the Legislative
3 Compensation Commission.

5 WHEREAS, The Legislature has authority to reject the rates of
6 compensation and salary for members of the Legislature set by the
7 Legislative Compensation Commission in the Commission's Order dated
8 October 19, 2023, and published in the Journal of the Senate and the
9 Journal of the House of Representatives on January 8, 2024, pursuant to
10 K.S.A. 2023 Supp. 46-3102, 2023 Senate Bill No. 229: Now, therefore,

11 *Be it resolved by the Senate of the State of Kansas, the House of*
12 *Representatives concurring therein:* That the rates of compensation and
13 salary for members of the Legislature set by the Legislative
14 Compensation Commission are rejected pursuant to K.S.A. 2023 Supp.
15 46-3102, and the rates of compensation and salary for members of the
16 Legislature prevailing for the 2024 Legislative session as provided by law
17 shall remain in effect.
