# SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 1737

#### As Adopted by the Senate

### Brief\*

SR 1737 makes findings concerning unlawful immigration, current federal immigration policies, fentanyl, the southern border of the United States, and the Governors from 25 states and Attorneys General from 26 states joining together to show support for Texas.

The resolution states the Kansas Legislature joins in solidarity with 25 states to support the Governor of Texas defending the state's southern border and its citizens.

The resolution also states that President Biden violated his oath of office by failing to faithfully execute federal immigration laws.

The resolution requires the Secretary of the Senate to send enrolled copies to the Governor of Texas, the Senate of Texas, the Texas House of Representatives, the United States Congressional delegation from Kansas, and the Senate President.

## Background

SR 1737 was introduced in the Senate by Senator Masterson and 23 other senators.
