The **agency** requests \$1,050,908, all from the BSRB Fee Fund, in expenditures and 9.5 FTE positions for FY 2024. This is an increase of \$26,476, or 2.6 percent, above the revised estimate for FY 2023. This increase is primarily due to increased expenditures to the Office of the Attorney General for legal services, increased expenditures for the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts for maintaining the licensing system, and resumed travel following the COVID-19 pandemic.

# **Omnibus Action (SB 25)**

1. Add \$96,352, all from the Behavioral Sciences Regulatory Board Fee Fund, and 2.0 FTE positions to implement Sub. for SB 131 concerning expedited licensing, contingent on passage of the bill for FY 2024.

## **State Finance Council**

1. Add \$25,776, all from the BSRB Fee Fund for a salary adjustment for most state employees based on the Department of Administration Market Survey and a 5.0 percent salary adjustment for employees with job classifications that are not included in the Market Survey for FY 2024.
