2023 Kansas Statutes

5-450. Appeals. (a) An appeal may be taken from:

(1) An order denying a motion to compel arbitration;

(2) an order granting a motion to stay arbitration;

(3) an order confirming or denying confirmation of an award;(4) an order modifying or correcting an award;

(5) an order vacating an award without directing a rehearing; or

(6) a final judgment entered pursuant to K.S.A. 5-423 through 5-453, and amendments thereto.

(b) An appeal under this section must be taken as from an order or judgment in a civil action.
