

2023 Kansas Statutes

72-3253. American sign language; instruction in accredited schools authorized. The state board of education may provide for the teaching of American sign language in accredited schools and all pupils thereof, whether hearing, deaf or hard of hearing, may be given instruction in American sign language.
