2023 Kansas Statutes

- **79-32,100a. Withholding tax; deduction by payer required.** (a) Every payer who is required under federal law to withhold upon payments other than wages as defined by K.S.A. 79-3295, and amendments thereto, shall deduct and withhold an amount to be determined in accordance with K.S.A. 79-32,100d, and amendments thereto.
- (b) A determination by the internal revenue service that relieves a payer from withholding responsibility with respect to payments other than wages to a payee shall also apply for Kansas income tax withholding purposes. Whenever a payer is required to reinstate withholding for federal income tax with regard to any payee, such obligation shall be equally applicable for Kansas withholding purposes.
- (c) Every payer who is required under federal law to withhold upon payments of a pension, annuity or other deferred income, as defined by K.S.A. 79-3295, and amendments thereto, shall deduct and withhold an amount to be determined in accordance with K.S.A. 79-32,100d, and amendments thereto, whenever the payee is a resident of the state of Kansas.
- (d) Every payer who makes a payment of a management fee or a consulting fee to a nonresident shall deduct and withhold an amount to be determined in accordance with K.S.A. 79-32,100d, and amendments thereto.
