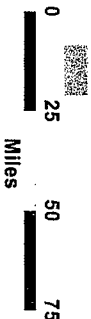

Great Bend and Baxter Springs

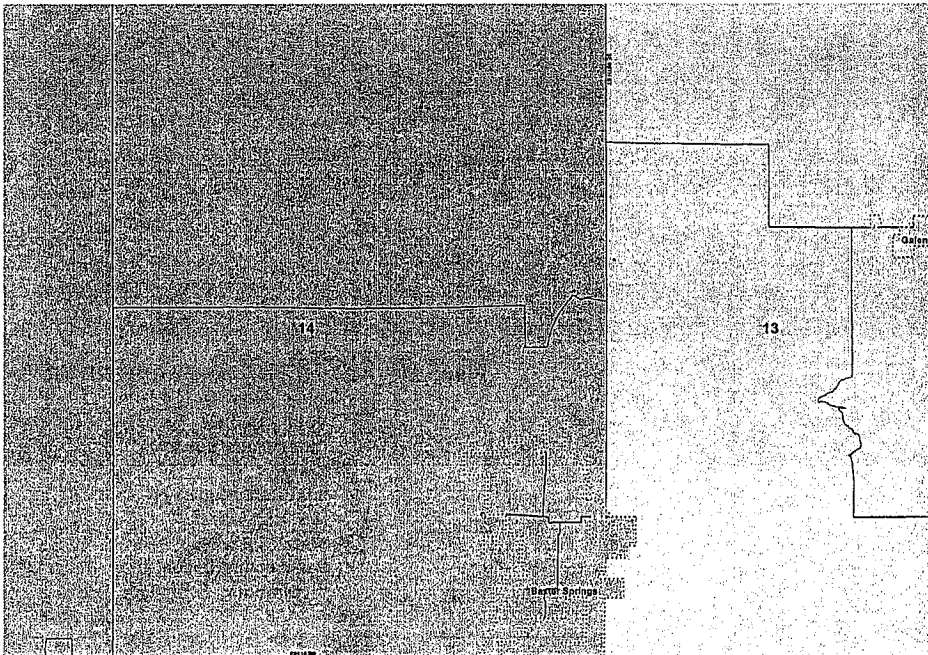
