Bill Introductions:

Joe Molina, Kansas Bar Association, requested introduction of five bills, as follows:

- A bill that would amend KSA 58a-1013 relating to the certification of a trust.
- A bill that would amend KSA 23-201 relating to marital property in divorce cases.
- A bill that would amend the Uniform Trust Code relating to a creditor's claims against a settlor.
- A bill that would amend the Probate Code relating to the application of certain provisions, the filing of wills and the order of assets appropriated.
- A bill that would amend KSA 60-2308 relating to certain exemptions from creditors claims for pensions and retirement moneys.

Lauren Douglass, Legislative Research Department, presented an overview of the *Report of the Special Committee on Judiciary to the 2011 Legislature*.

Senator Donovan made a motion to approve the minutes of the meeting of January 12th, as corrected. Senator Umbarger seconded the motion. The motion carried.

The Chairperson announced that in the future, minutes would be delivered by email to the members and asked that any requests for changes or corrections to those minutes be provided within the time period stated in the email.
