**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2530 by Representative M. Holmes

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2530 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Currently, the sexually violent predators who have been committed to the care and custody of the Secretary of the Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services (SRS) must be housed in a separate facility or building from all other patients. HB 2530 would clarify that the predators could be housed in a secure setting, such as the State Security Hospital where other security patients are housed, as long as the sexually violent predators remain segregated at all times.

Passage of HB 2530 would have no fiscal effect.
