**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2597 by House Committee on Government Efficiency

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2597 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

As recommended by the Governor's Office of the Repealer, HB 2597 would repeal a series of statutes related to agricultural seeds, the Seed Laboratory, the Seed Examination Fee Fund, seed testing, and the publication of inspection and exam reports.

HB 2597 is of a technical nature; therefore, enactment of HB 2597 would have no fiscal effect.
