AN ACT concerning civil procedure; relating to bankruptcy; exempt 2 property; earned income tax credit. 3 4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 5 Section 1. An individual debtor under the federal bankruptcy reform act of 1978 (11 U.S.C. §101 et seg.), may exempt the debtor's right to receive tax credits allowed pursuant to section 32 of the federal internal revenue code of 1986, as amended, and K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 79-8 9 32,205, and amendments thereto. An exemption pursuant to this 10 section shall not exceed the maximum credit allowed to the debtor under section 32 of the federal internal revenue code of 1986, as 11 amended, for the current [one] tax year. Nothing in this section shall 12 be construed to limit the right of offset, attachment or other process 13 14 with respect to the earned income tax credit for the payment of child 15 support or spousal maintenance. 16 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 17 publication in the Kansas register.
