2012 Kansas Statutes

23-37,303. Duty to enforce. (UCCJEA 303). (a) A court of this state shall recognize and enforce a childcustody determination of a court of another state if the latter court exercised jurisdiction in substantial conformity with this act or the determination was made under factual circumstances meeting the jurisdictional standards of this act and the determination has not been modified in accordance with this act.

(b) A court of this state may utilize any remedy available under other law of this state to enforce a childcustody determination made by a court of another state. The remedies provided in K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 23-37,301 through 23-37,317, and amendments thereto, are cumulative and do not affect the availability of other remedies to enforce a child-custody determination.
