2012 Kansas Statutes

- **58-3314. Judicial review.** (a) A person who has exhausted all administrative remedies available from the commissioner and who is aggrieved by an order pertaining to registration, a cease and desist order, an order of revocation, or any other final decision of the commissioner is entitled to review in accordance with the Kansas judicial review act.
- (b) This section does not limit utilization of or the scope of judicial review available under other means of review, redress, relief or trial de novo provided by law. A preliminary, procedural or intermediate action or ruling by the commissioner is immediately reviewable if review of the final decision of the commissioner would not provide an adequate remedy.
