2012 Kansas Statutes

74-49,133. Certification of action taken during 2012 regular session; procedure. The revisor of statutes and the director of legislative research shall jointly certify to the secretary of state that the legislature has received and taken action during the regular session of the legislature held in 2012 on the recommendations, including any legislation, of the KPERS study commission created pursuant to K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 74-49,132 as included in the report submitted to the legislature and the joint committee on pensions, investments and benefits by such commission.
