Who Are We?




- A customer-owned cooperative electric and natural gas utility in business since 1939.

Some Numbers That Tell Our Story



- 50,000 electric customers, 42,000 gas customers with about a third receiving both services. \$200 million in annual revenues.
- \$386 million invested in utility plant, with about \$40 million of new construction per year.
- 395 MW peak electric load.
- Irrigation is about half of our gas business.
