(e) Any seller who fails to comply with the requirements of (c) subsections (a), (b), (c) and (d) shall pay a fine of \$500 upon a first offense and a fine of not less than \$1000 upon a second or subsequent offense. (f) As used in this section: (1) "Seller" means any business subject to the provisions of article 36 (d) of chapter 79 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, and amendments thereto, who sells pre-paid mobile devices or SIM cards; (2) "pre-paid mobile device" means any cellular phone or similar wireless communication device for which the mobile device user purchases a set allotment of wireless communication services provided by a wireless carrier; (3) "SIM card" means a subscriber identity module or functionally January 1, 2014, equivalent data storage device; and and (4) "wireless carrier" has the same meaning as in section 6(4) of the wireless communications and public safety act of 1999 (47 U.S.C. §
