SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 296 by Senate Committee on Assessment and Taxation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 296 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 296 would amend current law to allow three additional public wholesale water supply districts to issue general obligation bonds to pay for the costs of acquisition, construction, reconstruction, or other alterations to public water supply facilities. The districts added would be numbers 13, 20, and 23.

The League of Kansas Municipalities indicates that it is not possible to determine what, if any, fiscal effect the bill would have on Kansas cities.
