

<b>Memorial/Commemorative Highway Signs, Payments Toward Those Signs</b>				
"The Secretary of Transportation shall not place signs until the Secretary has received sufficient moneys from gifts and donations to reimburse the Secretary for the cost of placing such signs and an additional 50% of the initial cost to defray future maintenance or replacement costs of such signs. The Secretary of Transportation may accept and administer gifts and donations to aid in obtaining and installing suitable signs."
