In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2149 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2149 would establish a system of reimbursement to medical care facilities that provide medically necessary donor human breast milk for any recipient of medical assistance under the Kansas program of medical assistance administered by the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE).

Passage of the bill would require KDHE to update rules and regulations and amend the Medicaid State Plan. The fiscal effect of the bill for KDHE would be negligible.
