SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2208 by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2208 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2208 would prohibit the sale or free distribution of powdered alcohol by any person licensed under the Kansas Liquor Control Act. The bill defines powdered alcohol as alcohol prepared in a powdered or crystal form for either direct use or for reconstitution in a nonalcoholic liquid.

The Kansas Department of Revenue states that passage of HB 2208 would have no fiscal effect on the agency.
