SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2353 by House Committee on Federal and State
Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2353 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2353 would make a technical change to the current school finance law regarding non-proficient pupils in determining the virtual school aid calculation.

The bill would codify the intent of the 2014 Legislature by eliminating non-proficient pupils in determining the calculation of virtual school aid. The Governor's recommendation for state aid to school districts in *The FY 2016 Governor's Budget Report* assumes that non-proficient pupils would not be included in virtual school aid calculations.
