SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2355 by House Committee on Commerce, Labor and Economic Development

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2355 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2355 would require that license agreements between movie distributors and independently owned drive-in theaters, where the license fee is based in whole or part upon attendance or box office receipts, not contain a guaranteed minimum payment. The bill would also prohibit a license agreement requiring an advance payment.

Passage of HB 2355 would have no fiscal effect on state agencies or local governments.
