SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2552 by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2552 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2552 would amend the list of state legal public holidays by changing Columbus Day to Indigenous Peoples Day. The bill would also remove Native American Day, which is not part of the list of legal public holidays.

Because HB 2552 does not add any new or delete any current legal public holidays, the bill would have no fiscal effect on state agencies.
