**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for SB 366 by Senate Committee on Commerce

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 366 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 366 would prohibit local governments from passing any ordinance that would control the rent or purchase price of privately owned residential or commercial properties when a price has been agreed upon by parties involved in the transaction.

The Kansas Association of Counties indicates SB 366 would have no fiscal effect.
