SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 436 by Senate Committee on Ways and Means

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 436 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 436 would establish requirements regarding the recipients of family planning services grants that are administered by the Division of Public Health of the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE). Family planning services grants funded in whole or in part from Title X federal funds would be subject to the following:

1. Grants would be awarded first to federally qualified health centers which include state, county and local health departments and health clinics; and,
2. Any remaining funds would be for grants to hospitals or federally qualified health centers that provide comprehensive primary and preventative care in addition to family planning services.

Passage SB 436 would have no fiscal effect.
