

## **SENATE BILL No. 139**

1 AN ACT designating a portion of K-7 as the mayor Ken Bernard memorial  
2 highway; amending K.S.A. 68-1034 and repealing the existing section.  
3

4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 New Section 1. That portion of K-7 highway from the southern city  
6 limits of the city of Lansing then north on K-7 highway to the northern  
7 city limits of the city of Lansing is hereby designated as the mayor Ken  
8 Bernard memorial highway. The secretary of transportation shall place  
9 highway signs along the highway right-of-way at proper intervals to  
10 indicate that the highway is the mayor Ken Bernard memorial highway,  
11 except that such signs shall not be placed until the secretary has received  
12 sufficient moneys from gifts and donations to reimburse the secretary for  
13 the cost of placing such signs and an additional 50% of the initial cost to  
14 defray future maintenance or replacement costs of such signs. The  
15 secretary of transportation may accept and administer gifts and donations  
16 to aid in obtaining and installing suitable signs.

17 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 68-1034 is hereby amended to read as follows: 68-  
18 1034. From the junction of United States highway 24 and United States  
19 highway 40 with United States highway 73 and highway K-7, United  
20 States highway 73 and highway K-7 north *to the southern city limits of* Lansing, then north from the northern city limits of Lansing to the eastern  
22 junction with United States highway 59 in the city of Atchison, United  
23 States highway 73 west to the junction with United States highway 159, is  
24 hereby designated as the Amelia Earhart memorial highway. The secretary  
25 of transportation shall place markers along the highway right-of-way at  
26 proper intervals to indicate that the highway is the Amelia Earhart  
27 memorial highway. The secretary of transportation may accept and  
28 administer gifts and donations to aid in obtaining suitable highway signs  
29 bearing the proper approved inscription.

30 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 68-1034 is hereby repealed.

31 Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
32 publication in the statute book.
