1 AN ACT concerning the disposition of district court fines, penalties and  
2 forfeitures; relating to the criminal justice information system line  
3 fund; amending K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 74-7336 and repealing the existing  
4 section.

6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

7 Section 1. K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 74-7336 is hereby amended to read as  
8 follows: 74-7336. (a) Of the remittances of fines, penalties and forfeitures  
9 received from clerks of the district court, at least monthly, the state  
10 treasurer shall credit:

- 11 (1) 10.94% to the crime victims compensation fund;  
12 (2) 2.24% to the crime victims assistance fund;  
13 (3) 2.75% to the community alcoholism and intoxication programs  
14 fund;  
15 (4) 7.65% to the department of corrections alcohol and drug abuse  
16 treatment fund;  
17 (5) 0.16% to the boating fee fund;  
18 (6) 0.11% to the children's advocacy center fund;  
19 (7) 2.28% to the EMS revolving fund;  
20 (8) 2.28% to the trauma fund;  
21 (9) 2.28% to the traffic records enhancement fund;  
22 (10) ~~2.91%~~ 4.4% to the criminal justice information system line  
23 fund; and  
24 (11) the remainder of the remittances to the state general fund.

25 (b) The county treasurer shall deposit grant moneys as provided in  
26 subsection (a), from the crime victims assistance fund, to the credit of a  
27 special fund created for use by the county or district attorney in  
28 establishing and maintaining programs to aid witnesses and victims of  
29 crime.

30 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 74-7336 is hereby repealed.
