AN ACT concerning school districts; relating to curriculum on winter celebrations.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) Any school district may include, as part of the history curriculum for grades kindergarten through 12, instruction on the history of traditional winter celebrations. As a part of such curriculum, students and school district employees may offer traditional greetings associated with winter celebrations. Also as part of such curriculum and in accordance with subsection (b), schools may display scenes or symbols associated with winter celebrations on school property.

- (b) Any display on school property that is authorized pursuant to this section shall:
 - (1) If any religious scenes or symbols are displayed, include a scene or symbol of more than one religion and at least one secular scene or symbol in such display; and
 - (2) not include any message that encourages adherence to a particular religious belief.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
