SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 6038

As Recommended by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

Brief*

HR 6038 would urge all Kansans to become educated about human trafficking and slavery and to work toward purging those criminal practices from the state.

The resolution also specifies that the Kansas Legislature would support increased education, stronger laws, and the promotion of justice to reduce the exploitation of all people worldwide.

Background

At the hearing before the House Committee on Federal and State Affairs, Representative Barton and the Deputy Director of the Anti-Human Trafficking Unit in the Attorney General's Office appeared in support of the resolution. Written testimony in support of the resolution also was submitted by the Attorney General. There was no neutral or opponent testimony on the resolution.
