Re: HB 2100 – Water Conservation Areas

Chairman Hoffman and members of the committee, thank you for the opportunity to provide testimony in favor of HB 2100. HB 2100 will allow Water Conservation Areas to have additional flexibilities that will allow water right holders to utilize their water more efficiently while also working to conserve more water through the overall conservation goals necessary to have a Water Conservation Area. It is important that this legislation include adequate safeguards to prevent the impairment of neighboring water rights. We believe that those safeguards are in place and encourage the committee to further analyze the bill to ensure that all water rights are protected.
