If you haven't been on the site for a while you must create a new password. When I first joined the legislature, we were given a printed pay stub. Later when we were switching to online stubs I was one of the ones that didn't want it.

When my daughter needs a W2 to apply for FAFSA or other proofs for college, it would be much easier and less stressful for me to have my one hard copy where I have filed it and not go through the struggle of fighting passwords and websites. It would also be easier when it comes to filing taxes.

Other people have similar problems. My assistant couldn't figure out how to get into her account at all, so she never saw her pay stub for a whole year! I believe people should be able to choose to get a hard-copy or an electronic pay stub.
