Personally, I have been in practice for 42 years. Our Kansas constituents have suffered over these years by not having a hearing aid insurance benefit. Every week, we see patients who could benefit from hearing aids, but cannot afford them, even if it's an entry level or basic hearing instrument. A young couple who both work and have health insurance but with a combined Income of \$51,000.00 and two children suddenly learn that both the father and the oldest son need hearing aids. Without a hearing aid benefit from the insurance, hearing aids will not happen for this family. An elderly individual with medicare and secondary insurance is on a fixed income and just cannot afford the amplification he needs to be able to communicate with his family, friends and caregivers. I wish I could tell you that our Kansas residents never encountered a financial hardship to purchase hearing aids and that their insurance benefits had a hearing aid provision to assist in the purchase of hearing aids.
