Subject: House Bill 2080

House Bill 2080 concerns rural water district benefit units. A benefit unit in a water district is a right that entitles the holder of such benefit unit to water service in the district.

House Bill 2080 would require boards of rural water districts to reinstate any benefit unit that has been forfeited due to delinquent payments upon payment of: (1) All unpaid fees and charges due to the district in addition to any fees and charges that would have accrued since the date of forfeiture; and (2) a benefit unit reinstatement fee which shall not exceed 20% of the water district's current fee to establish a new benefit unit.
