SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 389 by Senate Committee on Ways and Means

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 389 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 389 would define "de-identified student data" as student data collected or reported at the individual level that contains no personally identifiable student data. The bill would allow "de-identified data" to be disclosed to any public or private audit, evaluation or research organization, provided that any personally identifiable data is redacted. The bill would exempt de-identified data from certain tests, questionnaires, surveys or exams about a student's or parent or guardian's beliefs on issues of sex, family life, morality, or religion from being disclosed.

Enactment of SB 389 would have no fiscal effect.
