Subject: Bill Brief for HB 2474

HB 2474 removes the requirement for district courts to mail marriage certificate information to the secretary of health and environment.

The bill amends K.S.A. 23-2511 to remove the requirement for a judge or clerk to mail licenses and certificates of marriage to the secretary of health and environment. Instead, the bill will allow judges and clerks to submit the information from the license to the vital statistics integrated information system maintained by the secretary or submit the information in another manner designated by the secretary.
