Staff Notes

Bond & Interest is unaffected by the bill and the estimated amount is unchanged from the Governor's Recommendation

KPERS: The Governor recommended funding KPERS at approximately the FY 2016 amount. If KPERS was funded at the agency request, an additional \$113.5 in FY 2018 and \$162.1 million in FY 2019 would be required above the Governor's recommendation. Staff estimates an additonal \$21.5 million in FY 2018 and an additional \$26.2 million in FY 2019 would be required to fund KPERS based on the new school finance formula.
