SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2454 by Joint Committee on Corrections and Juvenile Justice Oversight

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2454 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2454 would allow a detention review hearing to be waived in writing by the juvenile and the juvenile's attorney with approval by the court. Under current law, a detention review hearing is required every 14 days.

The bill would also allow audio-video communications for all hearings. Under current law, only detention hearings may be conducted this way.

The Office of Judicial Administration indicates any fiscal effect resulting from the enactment of HB 2454 would be negligible. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2454 is not reflected in *The FY 2019 Governor's Budget Report*.
