**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for SB 210 by Senate Committee on Ways and Means

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 210 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 210 would exempt the University of Kansas Medical Center from the requirement that carrying concealed handguns cannot be prohibited unless adequate security measures are in place.

According to the University of Kansas Medical Center (KUMC), the bill would allow the agency to continue current policies regarding carrying concealed handguns in KUMC buildings; as a result, SB 210 would not have a fiscal effect.
