

HOUSE BILL No. 2072

1 AN ACT concerning motor vehicles; relating to vehicle registration, fees;
2 creating the Eisenhower preservation fund; amending K.S.A. 2016
3 Supp. 8-145 and repealing the existing section.
4

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 New Section 1. There is hereby created in the state treasury, the
7 Eisenhower preservation fund. Moneys credited to the Eisenhower
8 preservation fund shall be used by the Eisenhower foundation to honor and
9 champion the relevance today of the life and leadership of Dwight D.
10 Eisenhower. All expenditures from the Eisenhower preservation fund shall
11 be made in accordance with appropriation acts upon warrants of the
12 director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by
13 the state treasurer or the state treasurer's designee. Payments from the
14 Eisenhower preservation fund to the appropriate designee of the
15 Eisenhower foundation shall be made on a monthly basis.

16 New Sec. 2. In addition to any registration fee prescribed under
17 article 1 of chapter 8 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, and amendments
18 thereto, all applicants for vehicle registration shall pay at the time of
19 registration a nonrefundable Eisenhower preservation surcharge in the
20 amount of \$.50 for each vehicle being registered.

21 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 8-145 is hereby amended to read as
22 follows: 8-145. (a) All registration and certificates of title fees shall be
23 paid to the county treasurer of the county in which the applicant for
24 registration resides or has an office or principal place of business within
25 this state, and the county treasurer shall issue a receipt in triplicate, on
26 blanks furnished by the division of vehicles, one copy of which shall be
27 filed in the county treasurer's office, one copy shall be delivered to the
28 applicant and the original copy shall be forwarded to the director of
29 vehicles.

30 (b) The county treasurer shall deposit \$.75 of each license
31 application, \$.75 out of each application for transfer of license plate and \$2
32 out of each application for a certificate of title, collected by such treasurer
33 under this act, in a special fund, which fund is hereby appropriated for the
34 use of the county treasurer in paying for necessary help and expenses
35 incidental to the administration of duties in accordance with the provisions
36 of this law and extra compensation to the county treasurer for the services

1 performed in administering the provisions of this act, which compensation
2 shall be in addition to any other compensation provided by any other law,
3 except that the county treasurer shall receive as additional compensation
4 for administering the motor vehicle title and registration laws and fees, a
5 sum computed as follows: The county treasurer, during the month of
6 December, shall determine the amount to be retained for extra
7 compensation not to exceed the following amounts each year for calendar
8 year 2006 or any calendar year thereafter: The sum of \$110 per hundred
9 registrations for the first 5,000 registrations; the sum of \$90 per hundred
10 registrations for the second 5,000 registrations; the sum of \$5 per hundred
11 for the third 5,000 registrations; and the sum of \$2 per hundred
12 registrations for all registrations thereafter. In no event, however, shall any
13 county treasurer be entitled to receive more than \$15,000 additional annual
14 compensation.

15 If more than one person shall hold the office of county treasurer during
16 any one calendar year, such compensation shall be prorated among such
17 persons in proportion to the number of weeks served. The total amount of
18 compensation paid the treasurer together with the amounts expended in
19 paying for other necessary help and expenses incidental to the
20 administration of the duties of the county treasurer in accordance with the
21 provisions of this act, shall not exceed the amount deposited in such
22 special fund. Any balance remaining in such fund at the close of any
23 calendar year shall be withdrawn and credited to the general fund of the
24 county prior to June 1 of the following calendar year.

25 (c) The county treasurer shall remit the remainder of all such fees
26 collected, together with the original copy of all applications, to the
27 secretary of revenue. The secretary of revenue shall remit all such fees
28 remitted to the state treasurer in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A.
29 75-4215, and amendments thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance,
30 the state treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in the state treasury to
31 the credit of the state highway fund, except as provided in subsection (d).

32 (d) (1) Three dollars and fifty cents of each certificate of title fee
33 collected and remitted to the secretary of revenue, shall be remitted to the
34 state treasurer who shall credit such \$3.50 to the Kansas highway patrol
35 motor vehicle fund. Three dollars of each certificate of title fee collected
36 and remitted to the secretary of revenue, shall be remitted to the state
37 treasurer who shall credit such \$3 to the VIPS/CAMA technology
38 hardware fund.

39 (2) For repossessed vehicles, \$3 of each certificate of title fee
40 collected and remitted to the secretary of revenue, shall be remitted to the
41 state treasurer who shall credit such \$3 to the repossessed certificates of
42 title fee fund.

43 (3) Three dollars and fifty cents of each reassignment form fee

1 collected and remitted to the secretary of revenue, shall be remitted to the
2 state treasurer who shall credit such \$3.50 to the Kansas highway patrol
3 motor vehicle fund. Three dollars of each reassignment form fee collected
4 and remitted to the secretary of revenue, shall be remitted to the state
5 treasurer who shall credit such \$3 to the VIPS/CAMA technology
6 hardware fund.

7 (4) Until January 1, 2013, \$4 of each division of vehicles
8 modernization surcharge collected and remitted to the secretary of
9 revenue, shall be remitted to the state treasurer who shall credit such \$4 to
10 the division of vehicles modernization fund, on and after January 1, 2013,
11 the state treasurer shall credit such \$4 to the state highway fund.

12 (5) Two dollars of each Kansas highway patrol staffing and training
13 surcharge collected and remitted to the secretary of revenue, shall be
14 remitted to the state treasurer who shall credit such \$2 to the Kansas
15 highway patrol staffing and training fund.

16 (6) One dollar and twenty-five cents of each law enforcement training
17 center surcharge collected and remitted to the secretary of revenue, shall
18 be remitted to the state treasurer who shall credit such \$1.25 to the law
19 enforcement training center fund.

20 (7) *Fifty cents of each Eisenhower preservation surcharge collected*
21 *and remitted to the secretary of revenue, shall be remitted to the state*
22 *treasurer who shall credit such \$.50 to the Eisenhower preservation fund.*

23 Sec. 4. K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 8-145 is hereby repealed.

24 Sec. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
25 publication in the statute book.
