## HOUSE BILL No. 2551

By Representatives Deere, Pittman, Ellis, Eplee and Karleskint

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AN ACT concerning correctional institutions and juvenile correctional 1 2 facilities; prohibiting the outsourcing or privatization of any security 3 operations or facilities thereof; allowing existing contracts to be 4 renewed.

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*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:* 

7 Section 1. (a) (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no state agency shall enter into any agreement or take any action to outsource or 8 privatize any security operations-or facilities of any correctional 9 institution, as defined by K.S.A. 75-5202, and amendments thereto, or 10 11 juvenile correctional facility, as defined by K.S.A. 2017 Supp. 38-2302, 12 and amendments thereto, that is operated by a state agency without prior 13 specific authorization by an act of the legislature or an appropriation act of the legislature. The restriction imposed by this subsection applies to any 14 action to outsource or privatize all or any part of any security operation or 15 facility job classifications and duties associated with a security 16 operation of such correctional institution or juvenile correctional facility. 17

(2) For the purposes of this section, "security operations" shall 18 19 include the supervision of inmates in a correctional institution or 20 juvenile correctional facility by a corrections officer or warden as 21 those terms are defined in K.S.A. 75-5202, and amendments thereto, 22 or any other position that is part of security operations as identified in 23 rules and regulations adopted by the secretary.

24 (3) The secretary of corrections may adopt rules and regulations 25 to identify job classifications and duties that are part of the security 26 operations of a correctional institution or juvenile correctional facility.

27 (b) Nothing in this section shall prevent the department of corrections 28 from renewing, in substantially the same form as an existing agreement, 29 any agreement in existence prior to March 1, 2018, for services at such 30 correctional institution or juvenile correctional facility.

31 (c) Nothing in this section shall prevent the department of corrections 32 from entering into an agreement for services at such correctional 33 institution or juvenile correctional facility with a different provider if such 34 agreement is substantially similar to an agreement for services in existence 35 prior to March 1, 2018.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its

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1 publication in the Kansas register.
