SB 49 would amend K.S.A. 32-999 to allow the secretary of wildlife, parks and tourism to establish and change fees for both the public use of cabins owned or operated by the department and camping permits at state parks without with approval of the Kansas wildlife, parks and tourism commission and without a public hearing on such fees. The bill would also eliminate statutory caps on cabin rental fees and camping permit fees.

SB 49 would become effective upon publication in the statute book, on July 1, 2019.
