Subject:	HB 2451—Division of Animal Health Renewal Deadlines for Fees, Permits and Licenses

House Bill 2451 would amend the dates for renewal deadline date for certain fees, permits and licenses relating to livestock and domestic animals from June 30 to September 30.

The sections with renewal deadlines that would be changed to September 30 are:

- 1. K.S.A. 47-1001e and 47-1002: Licenses concerning the operation of a public livestock market;
- 2. K.S.A. 47-1208: All licenses and permits issued under chapter 47, article 12 relating to the disposal of dead animals;
- 3. K.S.A. 47-1503: Licenses to operate a feed lot;
- 4. K.S.A. 47-1805: Livestock dealer registration; and
- 5. K.S.A. 47-2101: Permits for the possession of domesticated deer.

HB 2451 would also amend K.S.A. 47-1831 to allow the animal health commissioner to require reimbursement for the actual cost of calfhood vaccination tags. Additionally, the commissioner would have the option to charge a processing fee for such tags, but the processing fee could not exceed \$0.25 per tag.

HB 2451 would be effective upon publication in the Kansas Register.
