The House Committee made amendments to require that these vehicles meet existing size and weight limits. KAC would urge this committee to carefully consider what types of vehicles should be utilized on public roadways and what, if any, additional signage or decals for oversized or slow moving vehicles should be required in this bill.

The safety of Kansans is important to KAC and its member counties. Ensuring that we are not introducing vehicles that may make Kansas roads a dangerous place for our residents and visitors is important. Thank you for your attention to this matter, and for your time and consideration.
