Subject: SB 57-Requiring review of information technology contracts by the joint

committee on information technology.

Senate Bill No. 57 requires that before a state agency enters into a contract for an information technology project of \$3,000,000 or more the agency shall: (1) Submit information concerning the project and the contract to the joint committee on information technology; and (2) allow for an opportunity for the committee to review the project and the contract and provide comments to the agency.

The bill also amends the statutory duties of the joint committee on information technology to require review of all state agency information technology projects and the corresponding contracts for projects of \$3,000,000 or more prior to the agency entering into such contracts and to make recommendations to the senate ways and means and house appropriations committees concerning state agency contracts for information technology projects.
