
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2564 by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2564 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2564 would require the chairperson of any legislative committee to provide any written testimony that has been submitted prior to a hearing of a bill to the vice chairperson and the ranking minority member of the committee 24 hours before the committee meeting. In addition, the bill would state that no chairperson could require a citizen of Kansas who is testifying before a committee on the citizen's own behalf to provide written testimony prior to the meeting.

According to Legislative Administrative Services, the enactment of HB 2564 would have no fiscal effect.
