
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2710 by House Committee on Energy, Utilities and Telecommunications

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2710 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2710 would require owners and operators of petrochemical manufacturing facilities and petroleum refineries to require its contactors and subcontractors to use journeypersons who are graduates of a federally registered apprenticeship program. This provision would apply to all contracts awarded on or after July 1, 2020. The provision would also apply to contracts awarded before July 1, 2020, if the work performed under the contract is completed more than one year after the date.

The Department of Labor indicates the bill would have no fiscal effect.
