K.S.A. 2020 Supp. 21-6322 is hereby amended to read as 7 8 follows: 21-6322. (a) Unlawfully tampering with electronic monitoring equipment is, knowingly and without authorization, removing, disabling, 9 altering, tampering with, damaging or destroying any electronic 10 monitoring equipment used pursuant to court ordered supervision or as a 11 condition of post-release supervision or parole. 12 (b) Unlawfully tampering with electronic monitoring equipment is a: 13

14 (1) Severity level-6 8, nonperson felony in the case of electronic 15 monitoring equipment used pursuant to court-ordered supervision or as a

16 condition of postrelease supervision or parole for any felony; and
17 (2) class A nonperson misdemeanor in the case of electronic

18 monitoring equipment used pursuant to court-ordered supervision or as a 19 condition of postrelease supervision or parole for any misdemeanor or

- 20 used pursuant to court-ordered supervision in any civil case.
- 21 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2020 Supp. 21-6322 is hereby repealed.
