Subject: Bill Brief on HB 2192

HB 2192 allows court services officers and community corrections officers to provide an identification certificate to offenders for use to obtain a new driver's license.

The bill amends K.S.A. 8-246 to provide that an identification certificate issued by a court services or community corrections agency to an offender under the probation supervision of such agency may be used as proof of a person's identity for purposes of obtaining a replacement driver's license.
